- **ACCESSING the Guillot University Center (GUC)**

Easiest access to the 2nd floor of the GUC is through the doors (indicated by the Trumbauer banner) off of the back by Parking Lot K.

- **GENERAL PARKING**

Due to the tremendous growth of UNA, we have acquired off-campus parking lots with a shuttle system running to the university. I know this is a drastic (dare I say Dramatic) change but our UNA Police have gone the extra mile to help us with the transition. They have added extra shuttles for transportation to our designated parking lot so that there should be a shuttle arriving and departing every 10-15 minutes. And for those "OH NO—I left something on the bus that I need right now!" moments, they will take you there in great haste in one of the cruisers.

Thursday-Park in Lot K (accessible from Pine Street) adjacent to the Guillot University Center for accessing the 2nd floor lobby of the GUC. Buses will unload on Pine Street next to Norton Auditorium.

Friday- Buses will unload on Pine Street next to Norton Auditorium and then proceed to park in the designated spaces on Stewart Avenue. Cars and Vans should proceed to the designated off-campus parking lot and take the shuttle to campus.

Saturday- Buses will unload on Pine Street next to Norton Auditorium. Buses, Cars and Vans are then free to park on campus. Please do not

use the satellite parking lot as there will be no shuttle service available on Saturday.
